Information about the collection of personal data

This information is provided in connection with the new Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which took effect on May 25, 2018. GDPR has replaced the previous law "Personuppgiftslagen" (PUL) (Personal Information Act) and is a regulation which means that the same rules apply in all EU countries.

This applies to anyone who processes personal data in his business.

The purpose of the new law is to strengthen the privacy of the individual. This means that we need to become more aware of how we handle personal data responsibly.

You also have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory authority "Datainspektionen" at datainspektionen@datainspektionen.se if you think the school is wrongly processing your personal information.
